

Kitty Play Zone Treasure Chest

What You Will Need:

- Computer Printer
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Construction Paper or Thin Cardboard
- Crayons or Markers (Optional)

Step 1:

Have your parents print out the diagram on the last page of these instructions. Using your glue stick, glue the diagram to a piece of construction paper or thin cardboard. Wait for glue to dry before continuing.

Step 2:

Using your scissors, cut the diagram out along the solid lines. Do not cut any of the dotted lines.

Step 3:

If you want to color your treasure chest, now's the time. Grab your crayons or markers and color the Kitty Play Zone Treasure Chest any way you like!

Step 4:

Lay your cut out diagram in front of you, with the colored side down, as shown here:

Fold the tabs of the “front” panel along the dotted lines. Now fold the sides of the “back” panel along the dotted lines. Finally, fold the tabs of the “bottom” panel along the dotted lines.

Step 5:

Fold the “front” panel along the dotted line. Using your glue stick, glue the tabs of the “front” panel to the inside (blank side) of the sides. Once it has dried, fold the “back” panel along the dotted lines and glue the tabs of the back panel to the inside of the sides, like you did with the front.

Step 6:

Fold the tabs on the “top” panel along the dotted lines. Now fold the sides of the “top” panel along the dotted lines. Using your glue stick, glue the tabs on the “top” panel to the inside (blank side) of the sides of the top panel.

Step 7:

Congratulations, you did it! As soon as the glue has dried you can begin using your Kitty Play Zone Treasure Chest. Try putting catnip or a cat treat inside the treasure box and putting the box in your Kitty Play Zone. Then watch your cat figure out how to open the box and get the treasure inside!
